

Community Quilt Block

10" x 10" finished 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

Propeller

2 Medium to Dark prints: Cut two 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares of print 1

Cut four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of print 2

Light tan background: Cut two 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Cut five 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Sewing directions: Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout construction. Layer a 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square of background right sides together with 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square of print 1. Draw a diagonal line and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the drawn line making your half square triangle blocks. Do this twice for a total of 4 half square triangle units. Sew a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " print square to a tan 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square four times. To make the center row, sew a tan 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square between two of the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units. Using diagram as placement, sew into three rows and then sew the rows together to complete your block.

Alternate directions: Cut each 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square in half on the diagonal line from corner to corner. Then sew a colored half square triangle to a light background half square triangle.

Repeat for all 4 sections.

Turn in your block to Community Quilt table at the next guild meeting.
