2010 JUDGED CATEGORIES

BED QUILTS: Must be at least 60" wide and at least 71" in length

- 1. Machine techniques—machine pieced and/or appliqué; machine quilted
- 2. Mixed - both hand and machine techniques used— Hand or Machine pieced and/or appliqué; Hand or machine quilted

WALL QUILTS: Must be a minimum size of 40" x 40"; Maximum size of 70" x 70"

- 3. Machine techniques - Machine pieced and/or appliqué; Machine quilted
- 4. Mixed techniques - Both hand and machine techniques used; Hand or machine pieced and/or appliqué; Hand or machine quilted

BOTH BED AND WALL QUILTS:

- 5. Hand Techniques – at least 40" x 40"
- 6. Group Quilts - Any quilt constructed and quilted by three or more people
- 7. Machine Embroidery – Machine or Hand quilted
- 8. Miniature – Maximum block size 5" square; 25" x 25" maximum size finished quilt; must be in a scale proportional to the scale of a full sized quilt
- 9. Small Quilts – Maximum perimeter of 156"
- 10. Art Quilts - An original design, any technique, max perimeter of 240" having at least 3 layers (front, batting, and back)
- 11. Special Technique Quilts - Quilts that incorporate one or more elements, which do not fit the guidelines of any of the preceding categories i.e. hand and/or machine embroidery less than 50% of the top, stenciling, whole cloth, yo-yo, cathedral window, photo transfer, etc.
- 12. Juvenile (12 and under) Ribbon only
