

2011 OZARK PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose: To assist a worthy sophomore, junior, or first semester senior with a declared major in a design-related field at a college or university in the greater Ozark area.

Award Component: One \$1,000 scholarship and 1 year membership to The Ozark Piecemakers Quilt Guild.

Selection Criteria:

- ❖ Enrollment of 12 hours or more each semester.
- ❖ Character and scholarship.
- ❖ Minimum 3.2 GPA
- ❖ Evidence of working towards a goal of creatively using fiber and/or fabric in a design or design-related teaching career.
- ❖ Leadership shown through campus, community, or other civic activities and work experience.
- ❖ Recipients must be from the greater Ozark area.
- ❖ **Renewable--Students can receive the OPQG Scholarship for more than one year but must reapply and compete equally with all new applicants in subsequent years.**

Selection Procedure:

1. Application can be obtained online through the website: <http://www.ozarkpiecemakers.com>.
2. Complete according to instructions and submit the application ***by mail only!***
3. Wait for notification of selection by the Ozark Piecemakers Quilt Guild Scholarship Committee Chairman.

Award Presentation: Recipients will be invited to attend a General Meeting of the Ozark Piecemakers to receive recognition for their accomplishments.

Award Payment: Fifty percent of the funds from Ozark Piecemakers Quilt Guild will be paid by check directly to the recipient's Bursar account to be applied towards tuition, books, or supplies needed for courses at the beginning of Spring 2011 semester and fifty percent of the funds will be paid by check to the recipient's Bursar account to be applied towards tuition, books, or supplies at the beginning of the Fall 2011 semester. Student must be enrolled to receive the scholarship for that semester.
