- ___ 2. Hand and/or machine techniques used-
Hand or Machine pieced and/or

WALL QUILTS: PERIMETER MUST BE BETWEEN 160" AND 280"

Entire quilt completed by one person:

- ___ 3. Hand and/or machine techniques used-
Hand or Machine pieced and/or
appliquéd; Hand or machine quilted.

Quilt completed by two people:

- ___ 4. Hand and/or machine techniques used-
Hand or Machine pieced and/or
appliquéd; Hand or machine quilted.

OTHER QUILTS:

- ___ 5. Group Quilt - Any quilt constructed
and quilted by three or more people
- ___ 6. Small Quilt – Perimeter must be less
than 260"

___ 7. Miniature Quilt – Maximum block
size 5" square; 25" x 25" maximum
size finished quilt; must be in a scale
proportional to the scale of a full sized
quilt

___ 8. Art Quilts – An original design, any
technique, max perimeter of 240"
having at least 3 layers (front, batting,
and back)

___ 9. Special Technique Quilts – Quilts that
incorporate one or more elements,
which do not fit the guidelines of any
of the preceding categories. i.e. hand
and/or machine embroidery,
stenciling, whole cloth, yo-yo,
cathedral window, photo transfer,
crazy quilts, etc.
