

Community Quilt Block

12" x 12" finished 12-1/2" by 12-1/2" unfinished

Railroad

Med to Dark Prints in scrappy blues: Cut ten 2-1/2" squares of Blue prints. Cut four 4-7/8" squares of blue print.

Totally scrappy, or each unit section matching.

Background: Cut four 4-7/8" squares of a white tone on tone.

Cut ten 2-1/2" squares of a white tone on tone fabric

Directions: Use a 1/4" Seam allowance throughout construction.

Make 5 - 4 patch sections and 4 half square triangle sections.

Draw diagonal line on the large white fabric squares from corner to corner. Place right sides of print and background together aligning edges. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the drawn line making your half square triangle blocks. Using Diagram

as placement sew sections together in 3 separate rows, then stitch rows together to complete block. **Alternative Sewing:** Cut the large squares in half on the diagonal line from corner to corner.

Then sew print to white, to make half square triangle blocks.

Turn in your block to Community Quilt table at the next guild meeting.
