

COMMUNITY QUILT BLOCK of the Month

Double Pinwheel

12" x 12" finished (12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished block)

Light-Medium yellow print: Cut 2 squares 6 7/8" x 6 7/8",
cut in half diagonally once to make 4 half-square triangles

White tone on tone: Cut 1 square 7 1/4" x 7 1/4",
cut twice diagonally to yield 4 quarter-square triangles.

Medium-Dark green print: Cut 1 square 7 1/4" x 7 1/4",
cut twice diagonally to yield 4 quarter-square triangles.



Directions: Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout construction.

1. Sew a med/dark print and a tone on tone quarter-square triangle along the short side using diagram for placement. Make four of these units. Press seam towards dark fabric.
2. Sew this unit to a half-square triangle of light/med yellow fabric. Make four of these units. Using diagram for placement assemble rows, then sew rows together to complete the block.
