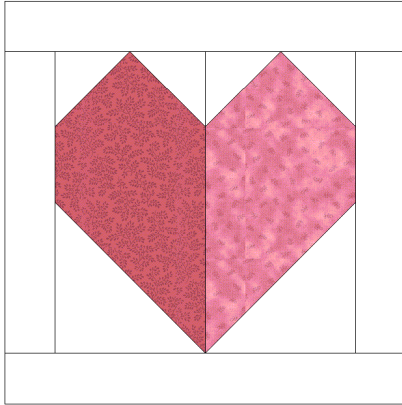

COMMUNITY QUILT BLOCK
12" finished (12 ½ unfinished) block

TWO TONE HEART



White or White tone on tone:

- Cut 2 – 5 inch squares
- Cut 4 – 2 ¾ inch squares
- Cut 2 – 2 x 9 ½ inch strips
- Cut 2 – 2 x 12 ½ inch strips

Pinks or Reds

- Cut 2 – 5 x 9 ½ inch rectangles

Directions:

- 1) On each white square draw a diagonal line. This will be a stitching line.
- 2) Check diagram and place a 5 inch square on each rectangle and stitch on the drawn line. They should mirror each other. Trim extra and press. (**Note:** Press one seam to the white fabric and one to the pink or red)
- 3) Place a 2 ¾ inch square on one top corner of rectangle and stitch on the line. Trim and press out.
- 4) Place the other 2 ¾ in inch square on the other top corner. Trim and press. (**Note:** Make sure where the seams meet in the center that they are pressed in opposite directions)
- 5) Stitch the two halves together.
- 6) Stitch the 9 ½ inch strips to the sides of the heart and press out.
- 7) Stitch the 12 ½ inch strips to the top and bottom of the heart and press out.

Turn in at the Community Quilts table at the February meeting. These blocks go a long way in making quilts for numerous agencies in our community. Your help is greatly appreciated!
