

Community Quilt Block of the Month

Juvenile/Boy Print

6" x 10" finished (6 ½ x 10 ½" unfinished)

Fabric1: Juvenile or Boy prints.

Cut one rectangle 6 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Tone on tone: Pick any color from your fabric for the triangle corners

Cut 4 squares 2 1/2"

Directions:

1. Draw a single diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each 2 1/2" square,
2. Lay a 2 1/2" square on each corner of the 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" juvenile print rectangle right sides together with drawn lines positioned as shown in small diagram.
3. Stitch along marked line on each square: fold out rectangle to see that you are square, trim excess fabric to a 1/4 " seam allowance, press seams towards triangles.
4. Easy block, make more than one as it takes a lot of blocks to make a quilt. ☺
