

Community Quilt Block of the Month

12" finished (12 ½" unfinished)

Woven Star

White tone on tone: background

Cut 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Cut 2 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"

Blue print fabric:

Cut 2 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8"

Red print fabric:

Cut four strips 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"



make 4



Directions: Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout construction.

1. Draw a diagonal line (from one corner to the opposite corner) on back side of the white 3 7/8" squares. Pair one blue print and one white print square, edges matched and right sides together. Stitch ¼" on each side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Repeat once to make four half square triangle blocks. Press seam toward color triangle.
2. Sew one white square to the blue and white half square unit just made, repeat for four.
3. Sew a red strip to the bottom of the units just made using small diagram for placement.
4. Using large block diagram for placement sew two units together to make a row (repeat), then join the two rows to make the block as shown.
