

Welcoming Windows by Edie McGinnis

Quilt Size – 43 1/2” x 43 1/2”

Block Size – 8” finished

Supply list:

1/4-inch Clover bias tape maker

44-inch square of batting

Freezer paper

Spray Starch

Paint Brush (I use one that has a flat edge)

Fabric:

1 1/4 yards green striped or fabric of your choice for the block centers, border and binding

1/2 yard black

1/4 yard green plaid – or fabric of your choice*

1/4 yard green and gold plaid – or fabric of your choice*

1/4 yard gold plaid – or fabric of your choice*

1/4 yard gold stripe - or fabric of your choice*

1 fat quarter gold for pineapple

1 fat quarter gold for vine

Scraps of gold and red for stars

Scraps of two different greens for pineapple leaves

1 1/4 yards backing

*If you chose fabric from a different colorway other than what is given, make sure you have a striped or print center and the fabrics surrounding the center compliment one another.

Thread, 1/4” foot, open toe foot, machine in good working order, iron, rotary cutter and ruler. Please bring a relaxed attitude and your sense of humor.

Please have your center pieces cut into 4 1/2” squares, your black cut into 2 1/2” squares and your other fabrics cut into 2 1/2” strips. Please DO NOT cut these strips into lengths before the class.
