

# Community Quilt Block

12 in by 12 in

## Next Door Neighbor

**Med to Dark - One each red & green print or Christmas**

Cut 2 each  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles. Cut 2 each  $3\frac{1}{2}''$  squares.

**White on White print:** cut eight  $3\frac{1}{2}''$  squares, cut four rectangles  $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$ .

**Directions:** Use a  $\frac{1}{4}''$  Seam Allowance throughout construction.

Mark one diagonal line corner to corner on the 8 white squares.

Place a white square on one end of a background rectangle, right sides together and stitch on diagonal line so when pressed it will start to make a flying goose block. Flip the corner up to

check your stitching. If it is correct, trim leaving  $\frac{1}{4}''$  seam allowance and press towards the

outside. Repeat on opposite end of triangle to complete the flying goose block. Make two flying geese blocks of each color. Mark one diagonal line corner to corner on the print fabric squares.

Sew one square of each print fabric to right side of white rectangle matching the picture.

(This is sewn like making one half of a flying goose block).

Following diagram make 2 sections of each color. Sew sections together.

Using Diagram as placement, sew into rows and then sew rows together to complete your block.
