

FALL 2012-SPRING 2013 OZARK PIECEMAKERS QUILT GUILD SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES

The Ozark Piecemakers Quilt Guild is seeking applicants for a \$1000 scholarship for a sophomore, junior or first semester senior with a declared major in a design-related field at a college or university (see Description page) for the 2012 spring and fall semesters.

Applicants are required to submit the following:

1. Application Form:

- a. Complete all information

2. Essay:

- a. Write a two page (maximum) typewritten, double-spaced, using 12 point standard font
- b. Include answers to the following questions:
 - i. Why are you pursuing a major in this particular design-related field?
 - ii. What kind of impact do you hope to have in this particular area? (Please be major specific, include goals, expectations, and how you intend to make an impact through your use of fiber and/or fabric as part of your design.)
 - iii. Please state why you think you deserve this award.
- c. Attach to application.

3. Transcript:

- a. Submit an official university transcript of grades.
- b. A minimum overall grade point average of **3.2** is required.

4. Portfolio:

- a. A photographic portfolio containing a **minimum of 5** pieces of work designed and constructed by the applicant (examples: art quilts, fiber art, clothing, process drawings).
- b. Portfolios may be in printed form (**maximum or 9" x 12"**) or may be submitted digitally on **CDs or DVDs**.

5. References:

- a. Three (**3**) letters of reference from instructors supporting the applicant's abilities in art of design, with a potential for successfully completing the academic requirements for a bachelors degree at your current college or university.
- b. Reference letters should be current, originals, and signed by the individuals who wrote them.

6. Return Envelope:

- a. A mailing envelope sufficient to handle all materials to be returned to the applicant.
- b. Address the envelope to applicant and affix sufficient postage for shipping.

7. IMPORTANT DATES:

- a. Application due date: between November 1 and deadline **March 5, 2012 by 5:00 p.m.**
- b. Applicants will be notified of results by email within one week following deadline.
