This is a class on how to use templates, basic curve piecing, and creating setting triangles using a curved block. Also included: Sewing an accurate 1/4" seam allowance and finishing techniques.

Fabric requirements

For the quilt:

Dark fabrics totaling 3 1/4 yards (at least 1/3 yard each)

Light fabrics totaling 2 1/2 yards (at least 1/3 yard each)

Border (pick from your light and dark fabrics)

    First Dark 3/8 yard

    Second light 5/8 yard

    Third dark 7/8 yard

Binding 1/2 yard

Backing 4 yards

For class: Bring 3 dark prints and 2 light prints at least 1/3 yard each

Sewing supplies

Basic rotary cutting system with long 6" or 6 1/2" x 12" ruler and 9 1/2" square ruler, small cutting mat (12" rotating mat is nice), rotary cutter; 45mm or 28mm, NOT 60mm. (I prefer the 28mm)

Sewing machine in good working order that you are familiar with preferably with a needle right position.

Neutral thread for top and bobbin.

Fabric scissors, fine silk pins (0.50mm or smaller), seam ripper.

Scotch tape.

Fine point permanent marking pen.

Collins Seam Gauge (red one with holes) Available for sale on my website.

A kit of templates is required for the workshop; Fee \$20 includes pattern and 9" Glorified nine-patch templates.
