

# Community Quilt Block of the Month

10" x 10" finished (10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished)

## Buckeye Beauty Block

**Light/Med Blue print #1:** cut 1 square- 5-7/8"

**Light/Medium pink Print:** cut 1 square- 5-7/8"

**White print:** cut four 3" squares or a strip 13" long

**Dark Coordinating Print #2:** cut four 3" squares or a strip 13" long

**Directions:** Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " Seam Allowance throughout construction.

1. Draw diagonal line on the large pink print fabric from corner to corner. Place right sides of pink and print #1 together aligning edges. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the drawn line making your half square triangle blocks. Press seam toward darker fabric.
2. Sew white and print #2 squares into a 4 patch square. Or strip piece the white and #2 print. Press seam toward the dark print. Then cut into four 3" segments and sew into two four patch squares. Using diagram for placement assemble rows, then sew rows together to complete block.
