

Community Quilt Block

10 1/2" X 10 1/2"

Double Sawtooth

Med to Dark print: cut 2- 2 1/2" squares any fabric.

Cut 6- 2 7/8" squares

Lt to Med coordinating print:

Cut one 6-1/2" square.

White on White print: cut 2-2 1/2" squares and

6-2 7/8" squares

Directions: Use a 1/4" Seam Allowance throughout construction.

Draw diagonal line on the white fabric from corner to corner.

Place right sides of white and print together aligning edges.

Stitch 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the drawn line making your half square triangle blocks. Repeat for 12 sets total.

Alternative Sewing: Cut the 6 print and 6 white squares in half on the diagonal line from corner to corner. Then sew a print and white half square triangle together, repeating to make 12 half square units. Sew three half square triangle units together (make two of these) and sew one to top and bottom of the 6 1/2" square. Using diagram as placement sew a print square, three half square triangle units, and a white square together (make two of these) and then sew one to each side to complete your block.
