

## August Block of the Month

Red and White

13" X 13" Unfinished

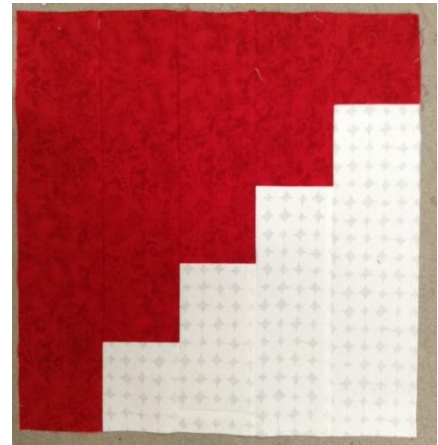
You will need:

Red fabric, tone on tone or a small print that reads red

White fabric, solid or tone on tone white

From the red fabric cut:

- One 3" X 13" rectangle
- One 3" X 10 ½" rectangle
- One 3" X 8" rectangle
- One 3" X 5 ½" rectangle
- One 3" X 3" square



From white fabric cut:

- One 3" X 10 ½" rectangle
- One 3" X 8" rectangle
- One 3" X 5 ½" rectangle
- One 3" X 3" square

A B C D E

Using ¼" seam allowances, sew a red square to a white 10 ½" rectangle along the short side (E).

Sew a red 5 ½" red rectangle to a white 8" rectangle along the short side (D).

Sew a red 8" rectangle to a white 5 ½" rectangle along the short side(C).

Sew a red 10 ½" rectangle to a white square along the short side (B).

Sew strip the red 13" (A) to strip (B) then using the picture as a guide, sew the remaining strips together.

Press your seams to the red on the short side and in one direction on the long side. Measure your block. It should be 13" X 13".
