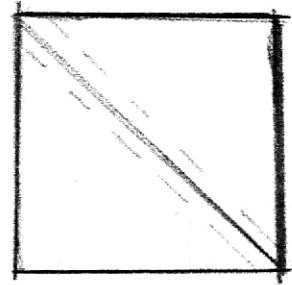
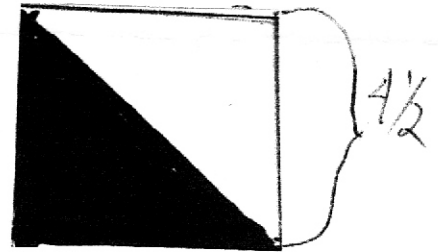

Quilt of Valor Block  
Shoo Fly Block



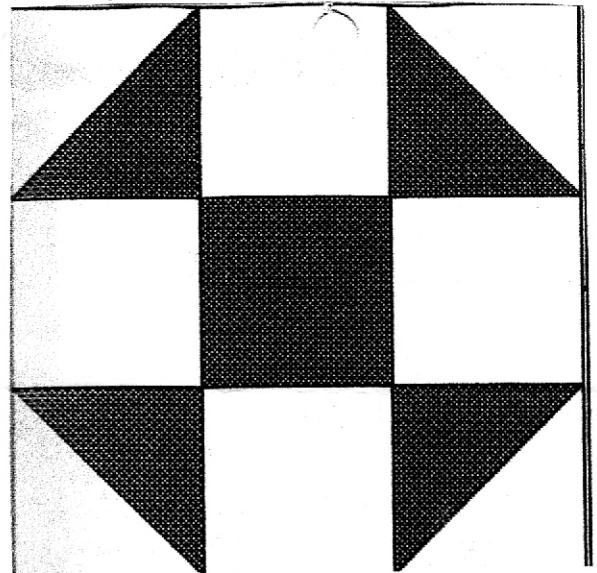
- Cut: two 5 inch squares from the blue fabric  
one - 4 1/2 inch square out of blue fabric  
Cut: four 4 1/2 inch squares from white fabric  
two 5 inch squares from white fabric

Sew: place the 2 white 5 inch squares right side together with the 2 blue 5 inch squares.



Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white squares.  
Sew 1/4 inch on each side of the diagonal line.  
Cut on the diagonal line.  
Press toward the blue fabric.

You should now have four blocks of blue and white half square triangles.  
Square up to 4 1/2 inch squares.



Sew the 9 pieces together to complete the block as seen at right.  
Press.

Your block will measure 12 1/2 X 12 1/2 inches square.

Turn in your finished block to the Quilts of Valor Table at the next guild meeting.
