QUILT OF VALOR BLOCK

Anvil $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

Red White and Blue

Cut from white background:

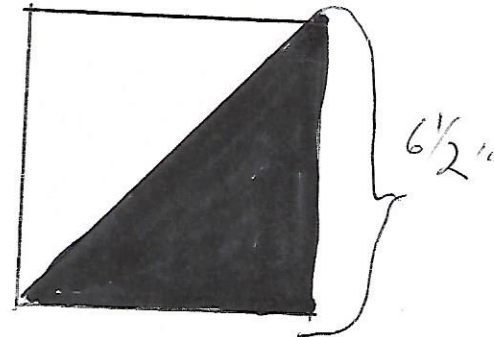
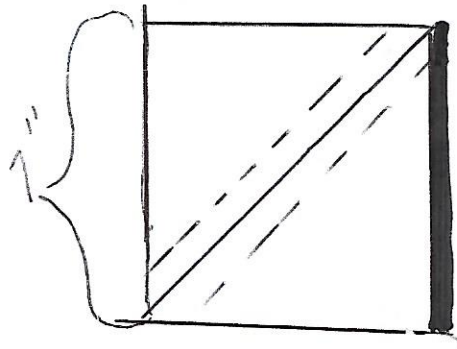
1. - 7 inch square
2. - 4 inch squares
2. - 3 1/2 inch squares

Cut from the blue

1. 7 inch square

Cut from the red

2. 4 inch squares
2. 3 1/2 inch squares



Directions:

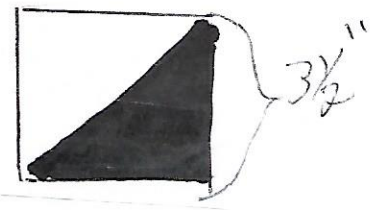
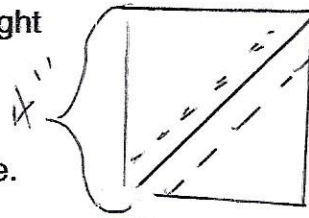
Place one 7 inch white background square right side together with the 7 inch blue square.

Make a diagonal line on wrong side of the white background square.

Sew 1/4 inch on each side of the diagonal line.

Cut on the diagonal line, and press toward the darker fabric.

Square up to 6 1/2 inch square.



Repeat with the red 4 inch squares and the 4 inch white background squares.

These will square up to 3 1/2 inch squares.

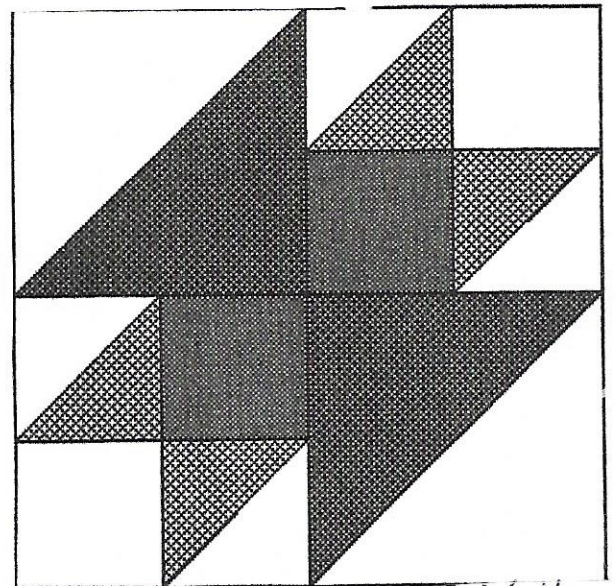
You will have 2 squares that are 6 1/2 inch blue and white half square triangles.

4 squares that are 3 1/2 inch red and white half square triangles.

2 plain white 3 1/2 inch squares.

2 plain red 3/12 inch squares.

Sew block together following the diagram.
