

JANUARY 2018 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

PURPLE PINWHEEL

12 ½" X 12 ½" Unfinished

Cut:

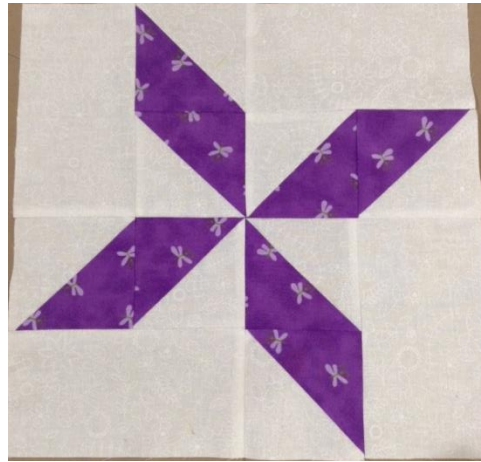
White solid or white on white:

Eight - 3 7/8" X 3 7/8" squares

Four - 3 ½" X 6 ½" rectangles

Purple small print:

Four - 3 7/8" X 3 7/8" squares



Use a ¼" seam throughout. Sew one seam and measure it. Make sure it is ¼". When you are sure you have a ¼" seam, continue to make the block.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of 4 white squares.

With right sides together, put a purple square together with a white square that has the diagonal line. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn line.

Cut along the drawn line and press toward the purple. Measure your block. It should be 3 ½". Trim if necessary. Make 8.

Sew 2 triangle blocks together. Make 4.



Sew a white rectangle to the long side of the unit you made above. Make 4.

Assemble the 4 units into the finished block above.



Press, then measure your block. It should be 12 ½" X 12 ½".

Turn in your completed block into the Community Quilt table at the next guild meeting.
