

July 2017 Block of the Month

An Internet Find

12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished

From a flowered print, fabric A, cut:

Four 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Four 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

From each of **two** coordinating fabrics (choose solids, tone on tone, or fabrics that read solid), fabrics B and C, cut:

One 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

One 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle



Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout.

With right sides together, sew the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together. Press. Sew a fabric A 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to each end of this unit.

With right sides together, sew a fabric A 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together with the same size fabric B and again with fabric C. Press. Sew a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to each side of these units. Use the picture as a guide.

Using the picture as a guide, sew all units together. Press. Measure. Your block should be 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
