### Disappearing 4 Patch

Unfinished 12 ½" X 12 ½"

You will need a small print and a coordinating solid color for this block. Your choice of color!



Cut two 7" X 7" squares from each of your fabrics.

Use a ¼" seam throughout. Sew your squares together to make a 4-patch block.



Using your ruler, make a cut 1" away from the center seam. Do this both vertically and horizontally.



Starting with the VERTICAL CENTER pieces. Flip them so that the bottom piece is now on the top and the top piece is on the bottom. Don't rotate the pieces, just switch places. Do the same with the HORIZONTAL CENTER pieces.



Sew your pieces together to complete the block. Press and measure. Your block should be 12 ½" X 12 ½". If not, your seams are not ¼"!

Turn in your block to the Community Quilts table at the next guild meeting.
